In order to set out the cavity trays accurately it is essential that some sort of guide line is set up for the bricklayer to work to. One cavity tray should be placed on every course of the abutment. The corner of each

cavity tray should be aligned with the dummy truss to achieve the correct spacing of trays and stepped flashing on completion. Manthorpe Building Products Product Information Sheet Cavity tray The external masonry walls of modern buildings are generally cavity walls, that is, they are formed by an inner leaf and an outer leaf of masonry, tied together, but separated by an air gap or 'cavity'. The cavity prevents moisture transmitting from the outer leaf to the inner leaf. Cavity tray - Designing Buildings Wiki The installation of a stepped cavity tray run or system should always start at the bottom, with the installation of a stop-end starter tray at the lowest point of the new roof's abutment. Stop-end starter trays are double-
